

2025 GET INTO ENERGY CAREER DAY

Ameren's Women Influencing Success in Energy (WISE) employee resource group will be hosting its 13th annual Get Into Energy Student Career Day on July 24, 2025, at Ameren Headquarters with students from across the region.

High school students will spend the day at Ameren, located at 1901 Chouteau in St. Louis, Missouri learning about careers available at an energy company. This includes energy careers in general, as well as career paths specific to Ameren. They will also go on a series of tours throughout the day to see areas that represent career paths at Ameren like touring the Trade Floor, our rooftop solar center, a substation, and our EV fleet, and mobile drone station. Students will also practice human resources skills necessary for applying for jobs, as well as interviewing skills.

Since 2013 more than 400 students have participated in WISE's career day to better understand energy related career paths. This is an in-person event. Transportation is not provided.
