Illinois Admin Code Part 466 Level 2 Supplemental Reviews – One Time Downsize Option Timeline

The purpose of this DER bulletin is to clarify the acceptable timeline related to exercising the one-time downsize and restudy option for projects that are studied under the Illinois Admin Code Part 466 Level 2 Supplemental Review process. The Illinois Admin Code Part 466.100(g) defines a one-time downsize and restudy opportunity if requested within 10 business days of receiving the Supplemental Review results. Ameren Illinois currently allows the applicant 15 business days to review and accept the Supplemental Review results.

Once the Supplemental Review results have been accepted by submitting the "Level 2 Supplemental Review Results" form in PowerClerk, the one-time downsize / restudy option will no longer be available to the project. The downsize / restudy request can be placed at any point prior to accepting the Supplemental Review results. This policy update will go into effect on **October 15**th, **2024** and will affect any Level 2 Supplemental Review for which the study results are delivered on or after that date.

Ameren Illinois is currently working to implement enhancements to the Level 2 Supplemental Review process to provide more information which can help applicants more clearly understand the significant system improvements, costs and generation levels at which these improvements are triggered.
