EV Charging for Employees

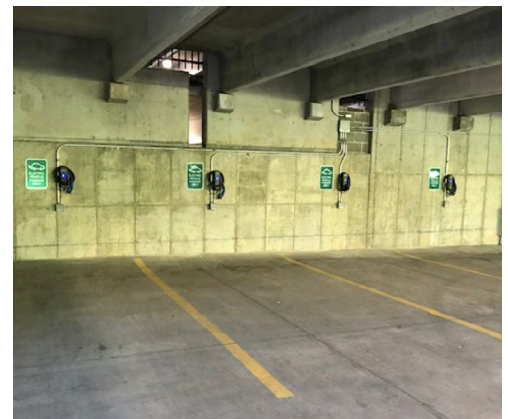
- Employees regularly make use of the seven charging stations.
