

Keeping Current



Help with paying down large balances and keeping your bill current through predictable monthly payments



This energy assistance program provides a monthly credit to help pay down large past-due balances. All you have to do once you qualify is make on-time payments.

How does it work?

- A monthly bill credit of \$30-\$90 a month helps reduce total amount owed each month. Bill credits continue for 24 months.
- Monthly Budget Billing payments must be made on time. Customer will be removed from the program if two consecutive payments are missed.
- Past-due balances can be forgiven with on-time payments over 12 months.

Are you eligible?

- You must have an active account in your name.
- Now through December 2021, your income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.
- You must make an initial payment of 1/12th of your total unpaid account balance.
- You cannot also participate in the Keeping Cool program.
- You must apply for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and Weatherization services.
